COVID-19 UPDATE

For immediate release

March 15, 2021

Today, the COVID-19 counts are as follows:

- Active Cases 1
- Recovered Cases 633
- Deaths 8
- TOTAL COUNT 642

The Health Department has not submitted a press release since February 26, 2021 for two reasons:

1. Cases are waning fast. We are currently down to only 1 active case.
2. Much information is provided on the NC DHHS website, including, but not limited to the number of cases (by zip code or county wide), deaths, vaccinations, and includes demographics. As of today, Hyde County has administered 2,902 shots. Of this total, 975 people are fully vaccinated, and 1,627 are partially vaccinated.
